Love at First Sight

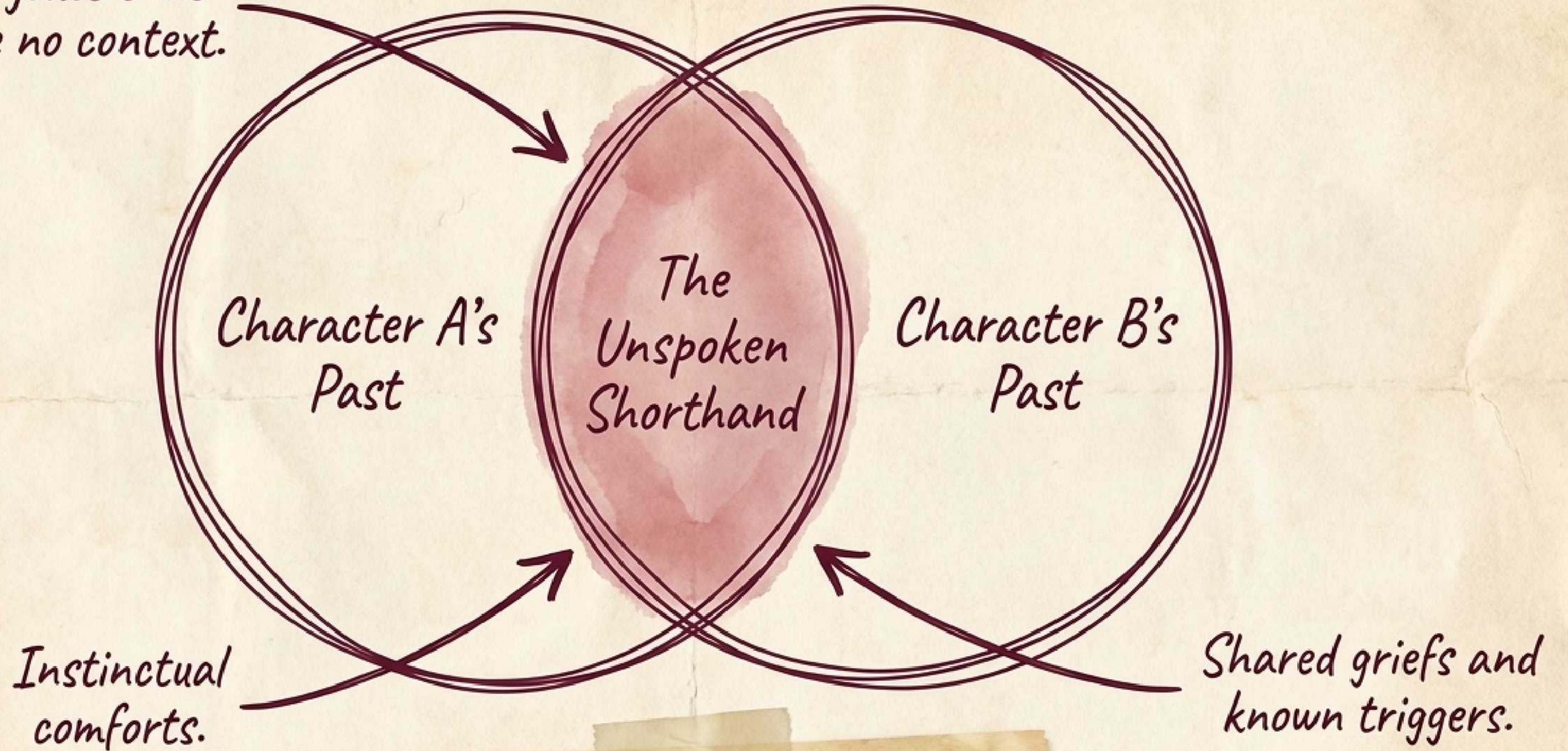
The glittering fantasy. Instant certainty, perfection from the outset, and the gut-punch of destiny.

The Reunion Trigger

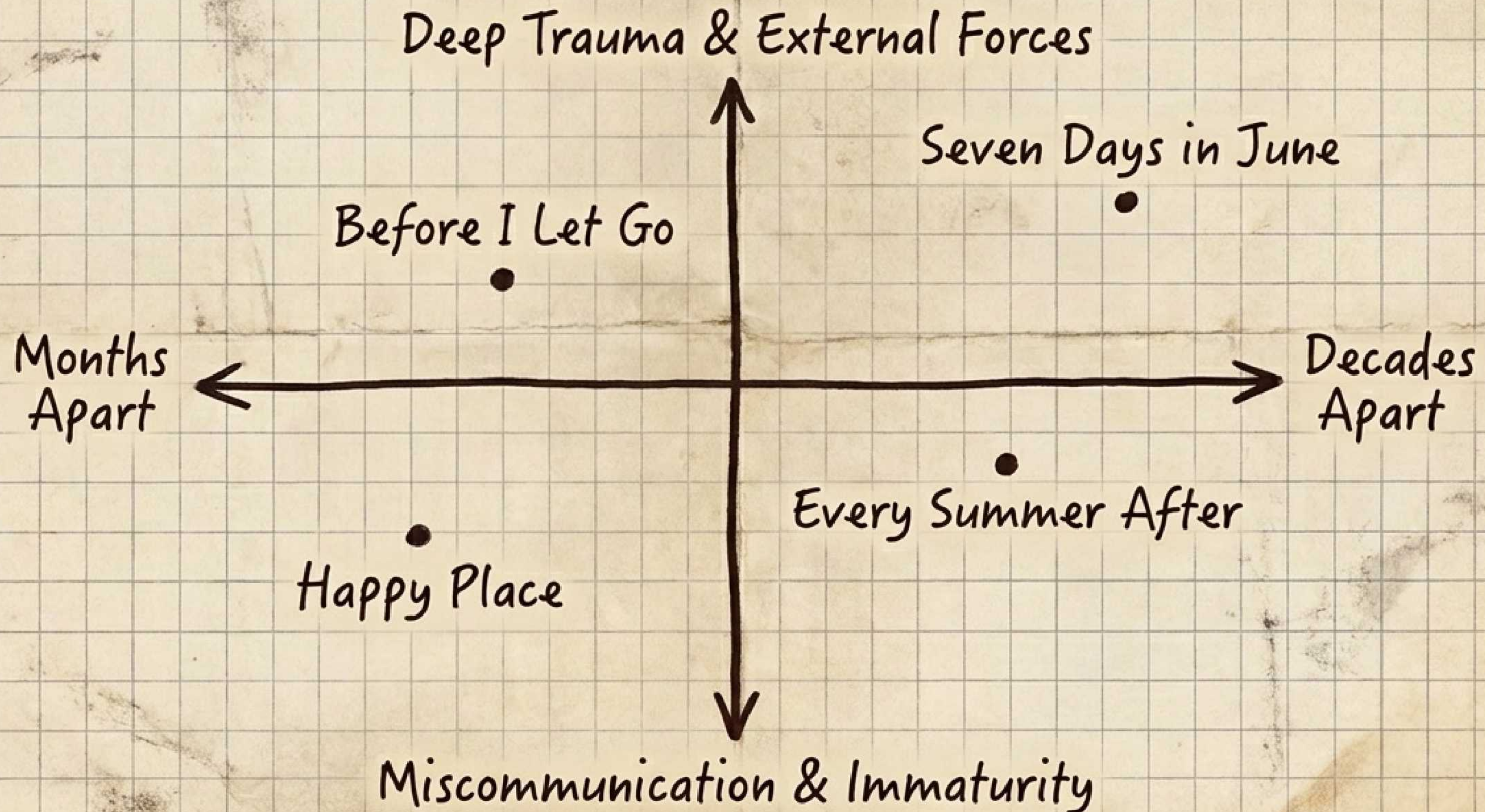
The functional plot device—often forced proximity—that drops them back into each other's orbit.

THE EMOTIONAL STAKES

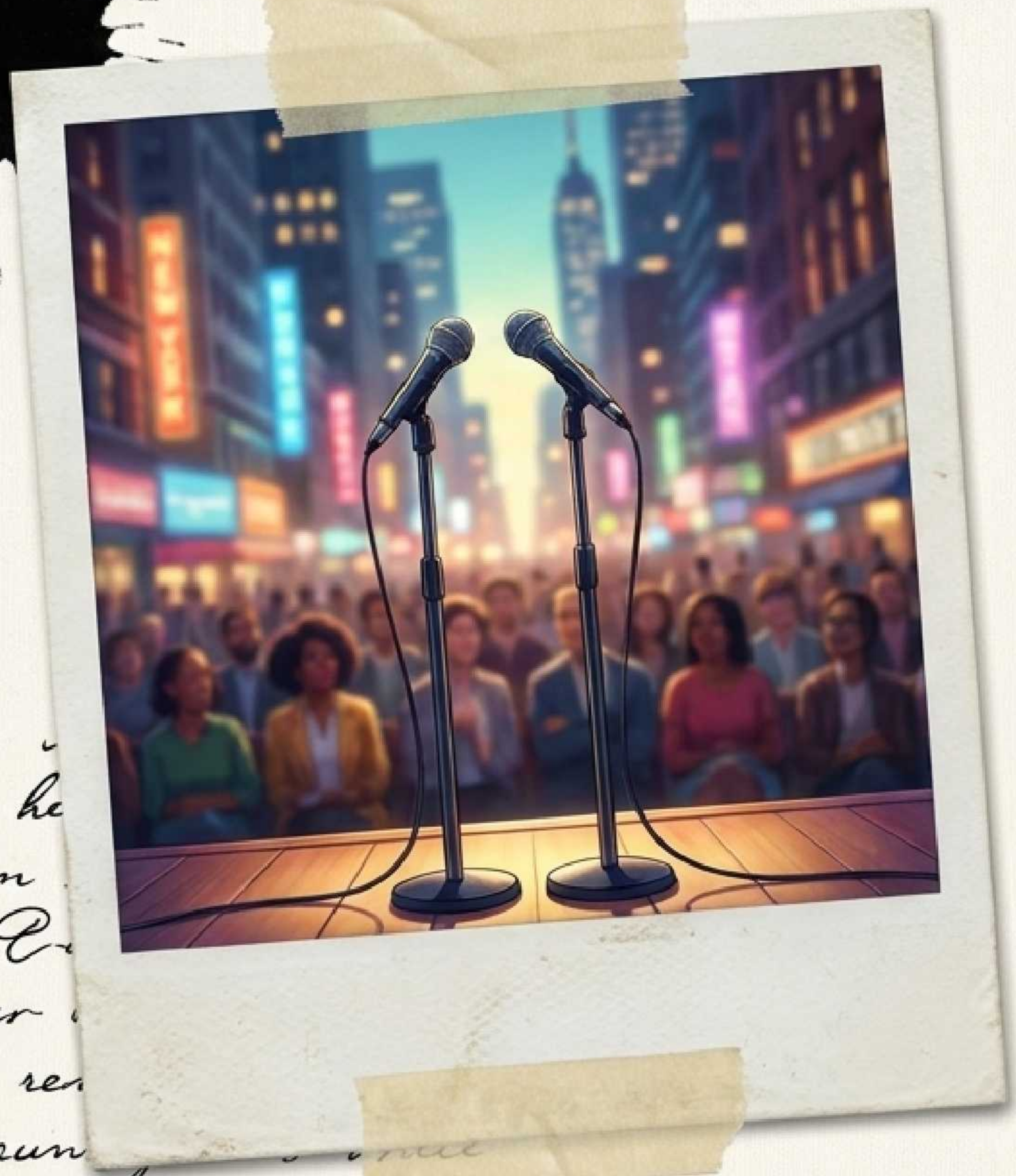
Risking a hard-won, amicable post-divorce peace to navigate immense trauma, therapy, and the terrifying prospect of rebuilding trust from the ground up.

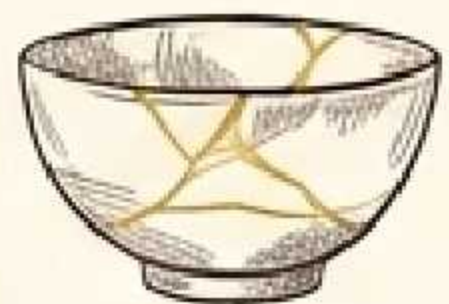
